



## **Postdoctoral position in plant pathology and molecular host-pathogen interactions**

A couple of postdoctoral positions are available in Dr. Fouad Daayf's laboratory to work and collaborate with other post-doctoral fellows and graduate students on different aspects of soybean, corn, or potato pathology. Each project may include both applied and basic research aspects.

Each of these positions requires a highly motivated individual with training in plant pathology and developed skills in molecular biology. Specific expertise in the molecular mechanisms of host-pathogen mechanisms and bioinformatics would be an asset. A high-quality publication record in the area of plant pathology is necessary. Applicants should possess excellent written and verbal English skills.

The positions are located at the Department of Plant Science, University of Manitoba in Winnipeg MB. Dr. Daayf's research program encompasses molecular mechanisms of plant-microbe interactions, biological control of plant diseases, and disease diagnosis.

The initial appointment will be for one year with the possibility for renewal.

**Start date:** Screening of candidates starts immediately, with an anticipated starting date in August 2019, or as soon as possible thereafter.
